Twenty Years at One McCurdy Road!

In November 2025 we will be celebrating the 20th anniversary of our church complex at 1 McCurdy Road. Our parish leaders and volunteers spent years planning, designing, and creating the facility that we now call home, and since we moved in we have celebrated Mass every day; rejoiced in baptisms and weddings and found comfort at funerals; educated our young people through Faith Formation classes; gathered together for dinners and special events; and reveled in the camaraderie of the annual Harvest Festival.

But twenty years has taken its toll on the bricks-and-mortar of our church complex, and there are a number of urgent repairs needed, as well as long-term maintenance that will ensure the future of our church complex. For this reason, the Parish Pastoral Council has decided that Christ the King Parish will embark on a capital campaign in this next year, with the objective of expanding our maintenance fund significantly. Between now and the launch of the campaign, we ask every parishioner to prayerfully consider their responsibilities as stewards so that we may fully realize our objective. We are also in the early stages of planning a fundraising event for late Spring or early Summer. 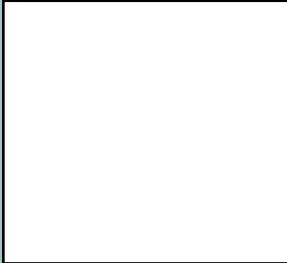

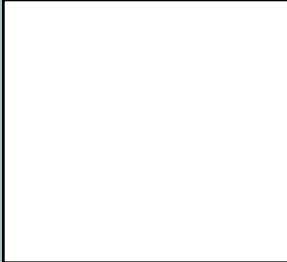

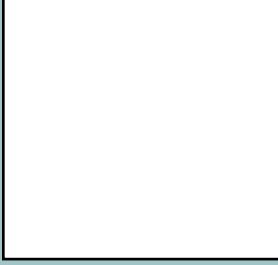
