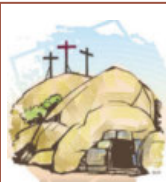

Bereavement Support for Mothers

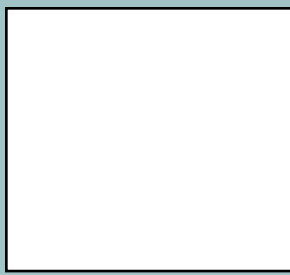

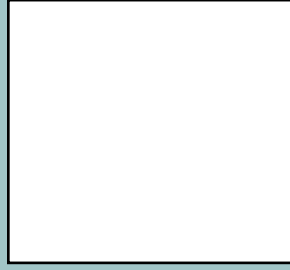

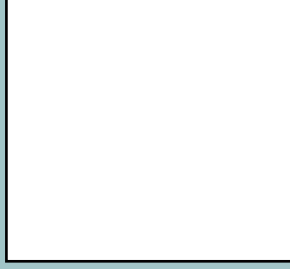
