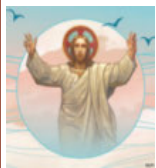

This year, Bishop Michael R. Cote, D.D., invites you to the **Chrism Mass at the Cathedral of Saint Patrick in Norwich on Tuesday March 26th at 10:30 a.m.**



The Chrism Mass is the Liturgy during which the Sacred Chrism is consecrated and the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of the Catechumens are blessed. These oils are sanctified for use at the Cathedral and in all parishes in the Diocese of Norwich for Baptism, Confirmation, the Anointing of the Sick and for the Ordination of Priests. Together the three oils symbolize the sacramental life of the Church. **Since the Chrism Mass is truly a Diocesan event, ALL parishioners are invited!**

Beginning in January, The Office of Faith Events will be offering a **7-week online course** taking place on Tuesday evenings that will prepare adults for Confirmation in their home parish.

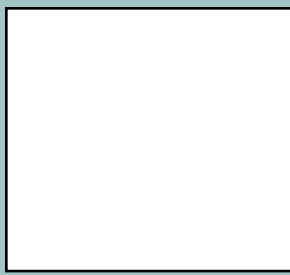

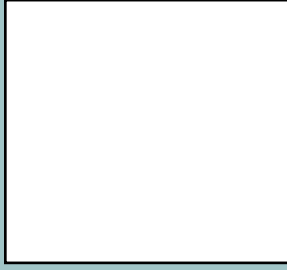

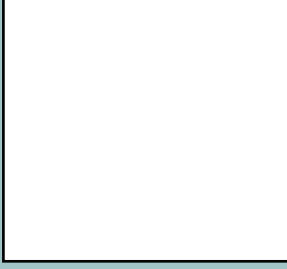
