Jim Griffin and the Glass Stained Window



Jim Griffin (shown left), a resident of Lyme and New York City, died peacefully at home on May 14th, aged 97. His wife Jane and their four children were with him.

Jim's connection to CTK extended over six decades. As passionate in

support of the arts as was devoted to his Catholic upbringing, Jim generously donated the circular stained glass window that sits high above the interior entryway to the church. The window was the creation of one of Europe's foremost stained glass artists, Michel Guevel (*right*), who Jim and Jane had first met in the 1960's in the iconic French cathedral of Chartres. The gift of the window married Jim's love of his faith with the central importance of beauty in our modern lives.


